Additional fundraisers may take place. Volunteers help with silent auctions, decorations, catering, checking in attendees, among other activities. ▪ Guild members may host a mini-fundraising event in their home (i.e. Curry Cook-off). ▪ Members seek donations to our Endowment Funds which help sustain orchestra salaries.
<input type="radio"/> Education Committee	<p>We support efforts to provide children and adults with opportunities to expand their knowledge and appreciation of music.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ In March 2011, young children will again be invited to our Musical Zoo and volunteers are needed to check in and direct attendees, handle refreshments, among other activities. ▪ We host Composer Talks throughout the Symphony's season with musician Bill Runyan discussing the composer(s) featured in that week's performance. Volunteers handle refreshments, signage, and room set and clean-up.
<input type="radio"/> Program Committee	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Members receive updates on Guild and Symphony activities at our general membership meetings held in September, November, March and May. This committee organizes refreshments, decorations, speakers and entertainment. ▪ Guild members may volunteer to host a general meeting in their home.
<input type="radio"/> Membership Committee	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ We hold our Bach's Lunch to recruit prospective members and our Margarita Mixer to welcome new members. This committee organizes the program, refreshments and decorations, among other activities. ▪ We manage the membership process, maintain the membership database using Microsoft Excel, and design/publish our annual Membership Directory/Guide.
<input type="radio"/> Calling Committee	<p>We assist officers and committee chairpersons by calling the membership when volunteers are needed or when surveys are conducted.</p>
